## WORKSHOP LEADER: DR. KHATCHIG MOURADIAN

This workshop aims at assisting community members to explore their ancestry, prepare a family tree, and learn about their ancestral town or village by tapping into a treasure trove of Armenian and Ottoman archival records, village histories, and demographic data.

During the first session on April 19, participants were asked the towns or villages from where they trace their roots, and the remainder of the workshop will be designed around those regions, including **Gesaria, Everek, Aintab, Kharpert, Palu, Dikranagerd, Erzerum, and Van.**

**DR. KHATCHIG MOURADIAN** is the Nikit and Eleanora Ordjanian Visiting Professor at Columbia University and the coordinator of the Place and Memory Project at the Center for the Study of Genocide and Human Rights at Rutgers University.
