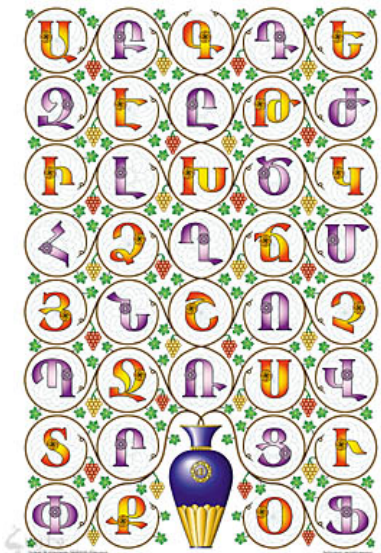

Students, Teachers, Parents

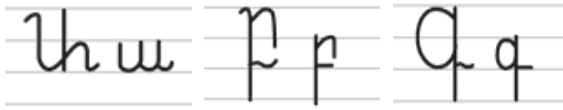

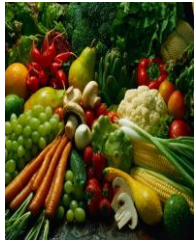
Writing
