

Synoptic Gospels No. 28, 29, 30, 31

Gospel of John 3:1-21 “Jesus’ Discourse with Nicodemus” Key words are that Nicodemus was called by Jesus to come and seek. The words come and seek are crucial to understanding this passage. Jesus guides him by connecting Nicodemus to truth, understanding. He who is not born from above cannot see the kingdom of God. He who is not born of the water and the spirit cannot enter the kingdom of God. The Son of Man (Jesus) has come from heaven to be lifted up as a sign that God loves all the world. Even the world in its very nature opposes Him, yet the Son has come to reveal and demonstrate God’s love and to lead those who believe to a new life in Jesus.


