

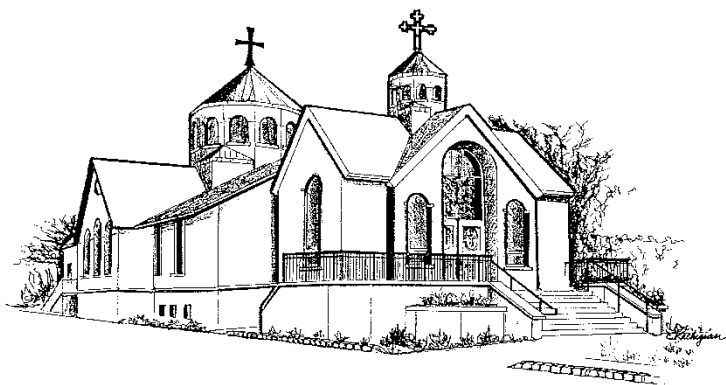

- 6) distribution of the Holy Communion, (p. 49).

* Also, please do not chew gum or cross legs during church services. Please observe the “arrows” in the new liturgy books. They indicate when you should *Stand, Sit, or Kneel*.

Book of Ezekiel

Chapter 33 “Ezekiel Israel’s Sentry”

Chapter 34 “Israel’s False Shepherds”

Chapter 35 “Judgement on Mount Seir”

Of all the things that the Israelite prophets were called by God to do, one of the hardest and saddest tasks was assigned to Ezekiel: he had to incorporate his wife’s death and his time of mourning for her into an enactment prophecy. By no means did this signify that God was insensitive to Ezekiel’s grief. Just the opposite is true. God’s own grief at having to punish His people and reject the sanctuary where they worshipped Him would have been a mirror for Ezekiel’s actions, and the Israelites grief at being driven from the home they loved was parallel to it as well. The points of the Oracles is that they reassure Israel that its foes will eventually be abased and Israel eventually be restored to greatness in God’s plan. This is a “Day of the Lord” passages, describe the Lord’s coming to intervene decisively in human affairs in the same way that a truly great king was popularly thought in the ancient world to be able to complete a war in a single day. The Lord, the great King of kings, would one day act in judgement against His enemies and on behalf of His people, according to the Day-of-Lord understanding.

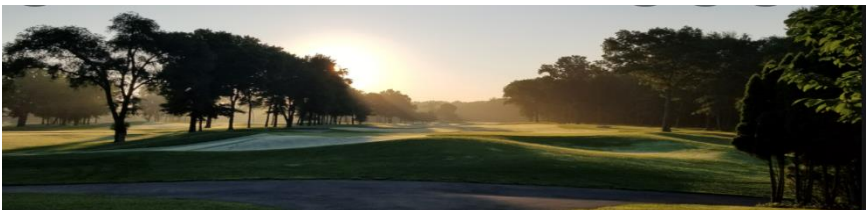

The Armenian Diaspora Survey (ADS) is a research project on public opinion in Armenian diaspora communities around the world, to inform the public, scholars, policy-makers and community leaders about the issues, attitudes and trends shaping the Armenian world in the 21st century.

Led by a team of academics, researchers and experts, the ADS aims to provide a snapshot of the contemporary Diaspora. The project fills a critical gap in the knowledge of the Diaspora and provides evidence-based understanding of the multilayered and diverse aspects of diasporic life.

ADS is funded by the Armenian Communities Department of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation and carried out under the auspices of the Armenian Institute in London.

This year, the survey will be held in the Armenian communities in **the United States and Ontario, Canada.**

The survey will be launched on **May 6** and close on July 29, 2022.

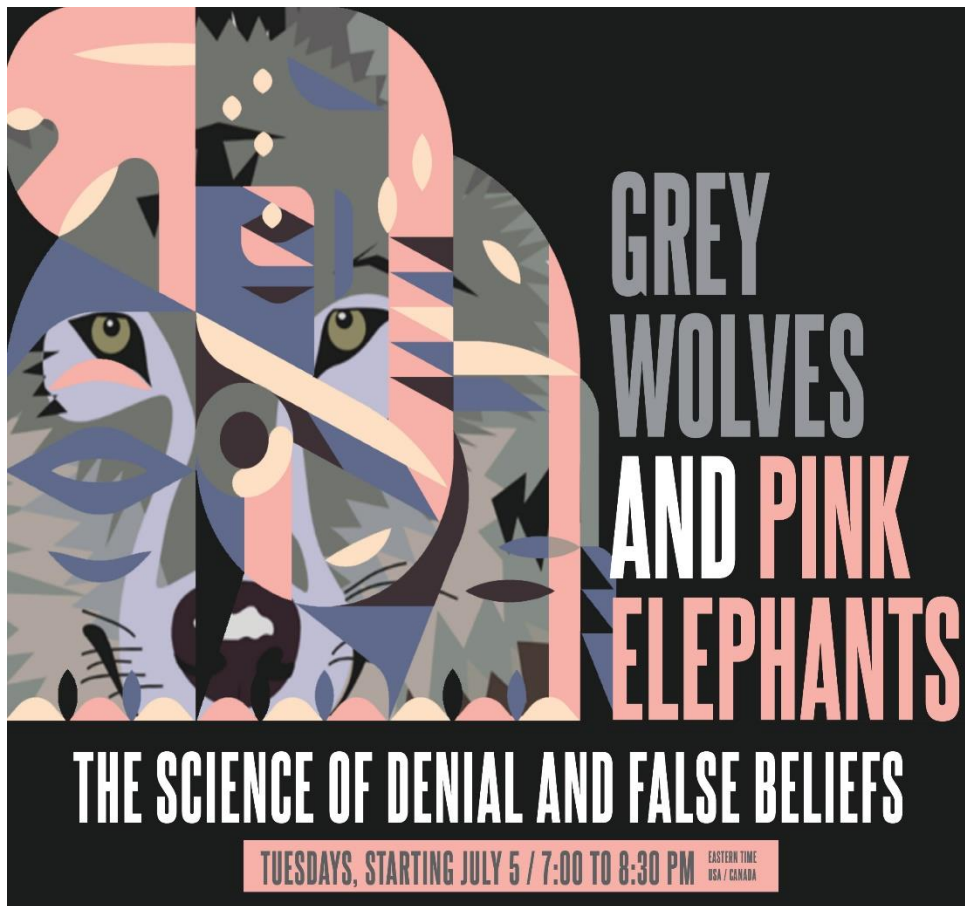

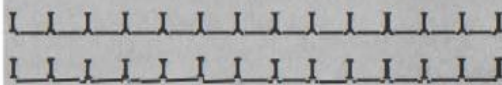

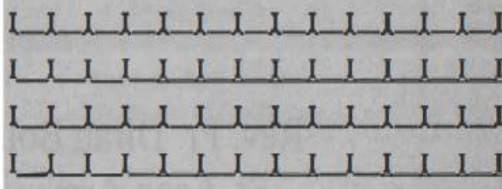
