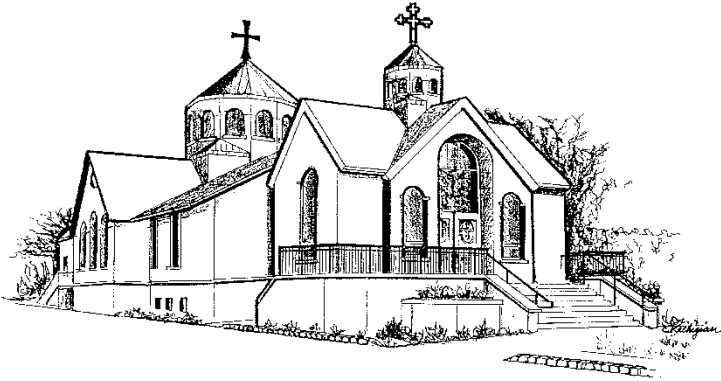

Նոյեմբերի 1-ին, նախագահությամբ Ն.Ս.Օ.Տ.Տ. Գարեգին Երկրորդ Ծայրագույն Պատրիարք և Ամենայն Հայոց Կաթողիկոսի, Մայր Աթոռ Սուրբ Էջմիածնում սկսվեց Գերագույն հոգևոր խորհրդի ժողովի աշխատանքները: Ժողովին, որպես ատենապետ, մասնակցում էր Կ. Պոլսի Հայոց Պատրիարք Ամենապատիվ Տ. Սահակ արքեպիսկոպոս Մաշայանը:

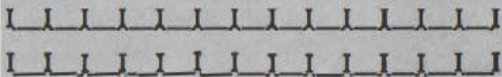

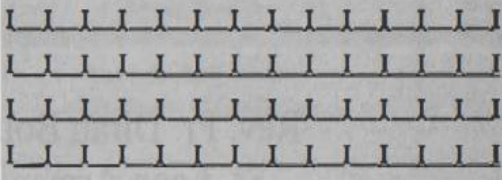
