

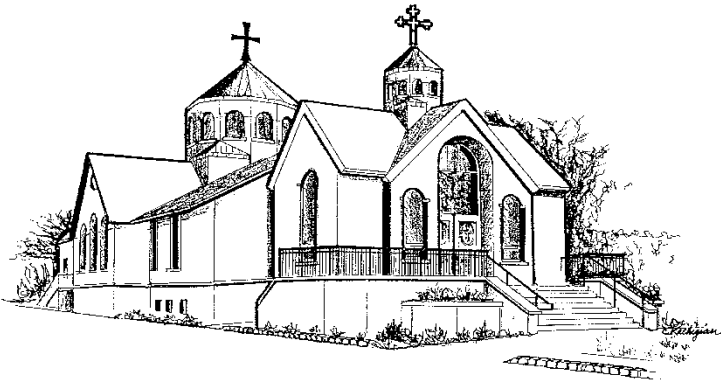

Our Visiting Clergy

VERY REV. FR. HARUTYUN DAMADIAN

The Very Reverend Father Harutyun Damadian (baptismal name: Artun Garabed) was born on September 14, 1988, in Istanbul, the son of Rev. Fr. Krikor and Yeretsgin Silva Damadian.

He graduated from the Kadukyugh Aramian-Ounjian Academy in 2002 and the Azkayin Getronagan Academy in 2006. After this he studied at the Kadir Has University and received a degree in electronic engineering in 2012.

In 2006, he received the Minor Orders tbrutyun and in the same year was made a stole-bearer uraragir. In 2008, he participated in the Patriarchal See's classes in preparation for the diaconate and was ordained subdeacon and deacon in 2011. In 2014, he enlisted in the special course of studies for the priesthood and in 2015 Archbishop Aram Atesian ordained him as a celibate priest bestowing upon him the name Harutyun Apegha. In the same year he was given special permission to bear the pectoral cross.

Following his priestly ordination, Hayr Harutyun was assigned as homilist at Saint Takavor Church. In 2016, he was appointed also as the summer-time pastor of the Prince Islands. In the same year he also assumed the office of visiting pastor of Kandili's Holy Twelve Apostles Church.

In 2008, he joined the Knale Island's Saint Nersesian choir, assuming the role of secretary of the director's council. He served in Kadukyugh's Saint Takavor Church during the winter months. As an active choir member, he also participated in concerts. He studied and mastered the Armenian Hampartsumian musical notation, hymnology, and liturgics. In 2013, he joined the Patriarchal See's "Armash" choir and continued until 2015.

In 2013 he was called to serve in the Patriarcharchate's publishing and information departments and continued until 2018. In 2015 Hayr Soorp joined the Patriarchate's ecumenical department and in this capacity participated in the Common Committee of Churches of Turkey. In 2021, he became the director of the See's Information Department.

From 2017-2021, Hayr Harutyun gave religious instruction in the Kalfaian Academy.

Hayr Soorp is the author of three books: "The Holy Land Calls" (2012), "Reflections for the Forty Days" (2017), and "Weekly Reflections" (2019). In 2021, together with the Rev. Fr. Krikor Damadian, he translated from Turkish into Armenian "Foundational Christian Principles".

Folloing his priestly ordination, Hayr Harutyun authored sermons and religious articles for the "Jhamanag" and "Marmara" daily newspapers, the "Holy Savior" monthly newsletter, and wrote columns in other papers.

In November 2021, upon the request of His Beatitude Patriarch Sahag II and with the blessing of His Holiness Karekin II, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians, Hayr Soorp was sent to the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin, to work temporarily under the auspices of the Mother See and to complete his vartabedagan research project.

On June 8, 2022, he defended his thesis titled "The Monastic/Seminary Life of the Patriarchate of Constantinople" and on June 11, 2022, in Oshagan's Saint Mesrop Mashdots Church, Hayr Soorp was granted the rank of vartabed (archimandrite) and was given the right to use the vartabedagan staff by Archbishop Natan Ohanessian

During his time residing in the Mother See, Hayr Harutyun wrote articles about various monasteries and churches in Armenia for the Istanbul Armenian press, describing everyday life in these places of prayer.
