



In our last bible study we covered four books; Zephaniah, Nahum, Habakkuk and Obadiah.

Zephaniah- Hear the word of the Lord-the first words out of the mouth of the Prophet: 1:2 "I will sweep away everything from the face of the earth" That is a promise from God. Zephaniah lived in a day when most Israelites didn't worship God any longer. They worship gods of other nations and even sacrificed their children to appease the idols. Zephaniah predicts the destruction of Judah and the surrounding nations. Punishment for sin is the theme.

Nahum- the prophet says that God will soon annihilate Assyria, an empire that has too long terrorized the entire Middle East. Evil is real and the Israelites know that all to well. But so is the justice of God. Sooner or later, but always in God's timing, evil is stopped and the guilty are punished.

Habakkuk- Why does God sit by and do nothing when good people suffer at the hands of the wicked? That is Habakkuk's question to God. Judah became morally impure. It bred extortion, violence and swarms of criminals out for blood. The Babylonians were even more wicked and God assured Habakkuk that they would receive own judgement. God said, Let the world be silent- the Lord is present in Holy Temple, in that he wanted the Israelites to trust Him. Obadiah-the prophet saw the injustice from the neighboring invaders and the Israelite went to their cousins the Edomites for protection but, unfortunately the Edomites turned on them also. If Obadiah and the other prophets said only one thing about God, they said this: God settles his accounts. And he does it justly. Sooner or later, sometimes later, sin is always punished. The story of Edom is just one of many examples in the Bible. Justice may sometimes be outside our reach. But it is always within God's reach. And in due time, justice will be victorious.
