# Pentecost / Hampartzum



"When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability." (Acts 2:1-4)

Most enigmatic of the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit is the focal point of the feast day celebrated this Sunday.

Called Pentecost because it occurred fifty days after the Resurrection of Jesus Christ (Easter), the feast of Pentecost is known in Armenia as Anqtquinlum/Hokekalusd, meaning "the coming of the Spirit." Biblical in its origin, the original event celebrated on the feast day is recorded early in the Book of Acts, ten days after the Ascension (Audpupanlu/Hampartzum) of Jesus. Christ Himself had told the apostles that they would "be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now" (Acts 1:5). Effectively, after Christ's return to heaven, the Holy Spirit is the Person of the Trinity who strengthened the apostles, and by extension, Christians through the ages. Christians believe that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit all continue to act in the world. Yet the events of Pentecost suggest that the Holy Spirit is a powerful actor and source for everyday Christian life.



#### **Synoptic Gospels**

"The Healing of the Paralytic" No. 43

"The Call of Levi" No. 44

In this passage we see how Jesus calls the first disciples which is unique among the synoptic Gospels.

While Mark and Matthew speak of Jesus walking along the Sea of Galilee and quickly calling Simon, Andrew, James, and John to follow him (Matt. 4:18, Mark 1:16-20).


Only Luke tells the story of the miraculous catch of fish preceding the call. Jesus offers and unsolicited fishing advice which at first didn't make sense to the disciples but because they heard Jesus' teaching, they cast their nets out again.

Peter at first addresses Jesus as Master.

After Jesus' performs the miracle and the net of the fisherman were full of fish, Peter address Jesus as Lord. The disciples start learning and growing in the relationship with Jesus.

In the Passage of the "Cleansing of the Leper", the man in humility approaches Jesus who is full of Leprosy to be healed. Jesus doesn't hesitate and touches and heals the leper out of love and compassion and made him clean, even though he was seen as unclean by the Pharisees.


